Validity of CSBI Results

Given the brevity of the CSBI, even a few missing responses present a problem for interpretation. The normative sample contains only those parents who completed all items. It is important to follow up with the caregiver on any missing items and to view the CSBI scores as invalid if more than two items are not completed. There are no missing item responses in this protocol, so missing items do not present a problem for interpretation.

Interpretive Caveats

It is important to clarify endorsement of any of the more unusual items. For example, when caregivers endorse Item 18, *Puts objects in vagina or rectum*, it is helpful to clarify exactly what the caregiver witnessed (e.g., between the buttocks vs. inside the rectum or between the labia vs. inside the vagina).
